So, how much will this cost?

Saint Leo University's direct costs for the 2009-2010 school year are: \$26,370. These costs include: tuition, room (standard double), meal plan (unlimited), Student Activity Fee, and an Orientation Fee (freshman only).

But keep in mind that 93% of all Saint Leo students receive some form of financial aid. To give you a better idea of what financial aid packages can include, we've provided the examples below for Florida residents and out-of-state residents based on annual family income. You can also use our your family's contribution toward tuition.

Even with this help, the financial aid process can still be challenging. That's why your Saint Leo admission counselor and financial aid advisor will work personally with you and your family to help navigate the process.
