


## Accessing Free Redshelf E-books through Redshelf Responds

#1. Follow this link: <https://studentresponse.redshelf.com/>, and when you reach the page pictured below, enter your title or ISBN# into the search bar at the bottom of the screen





**#3.** Next, you will need to either log in to your Redshelf.com account if you already have one, or create a new account. To create a new account, you will need to enter and confirm your Saint Leo E-mail address (be sure to use your @email.saintleo.edu address. This will not work with any other e-mail address), and you will need to create and confirm a password, enter your date of birth, indicate that you are a student at Saint Leo University, and you will need to agree to the terms of use and privacy policy. The click on the blue Create Account button.

**#4.** Having created or logged in to your account, you will then be brought back to the page for the book, where you need to click on the blue Add To My Shelf Button.


