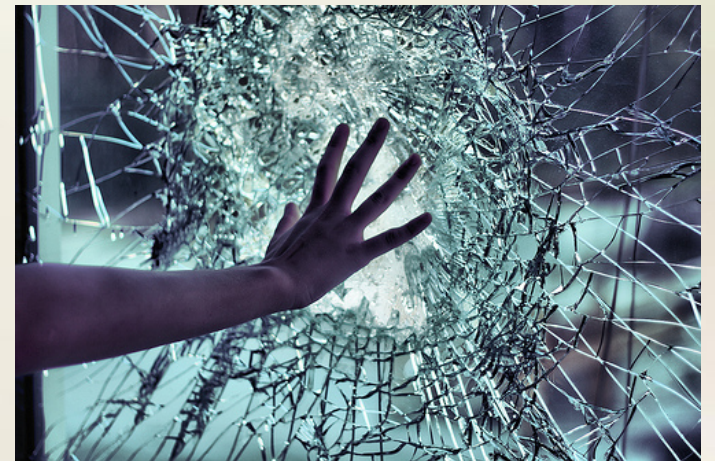

 - Create commonly used responses
 - Assess grammar

Exams and Quizzes

- Quiz feature in D2L under Activities tab.
- Different question types.
- Can set up for automatic grading or instructor can grade.

Entry Slips

- What is an entry slip?
- Evolution of entry slips.
- Using the discussion board.
 - Can include start and end date.
 - Can include assessment so linked to gradebook.
 - Can require student responses to classmates.

Exit Slips

- What is an exit slip?
 - 3 things you learned and 1 question
- Using the discussion board.
 - Can include start and end date.
 - Can include assessment so linked to gradebook.
 - Can require student responses to classmates.

Other Ways to Use the Discussion Forum

- Video reactions
- Paired Debates
- Individual presentation submissions

Group Presentations

- Presentations in Zoom.
 - Can see all group members.
- Group member rating form.
