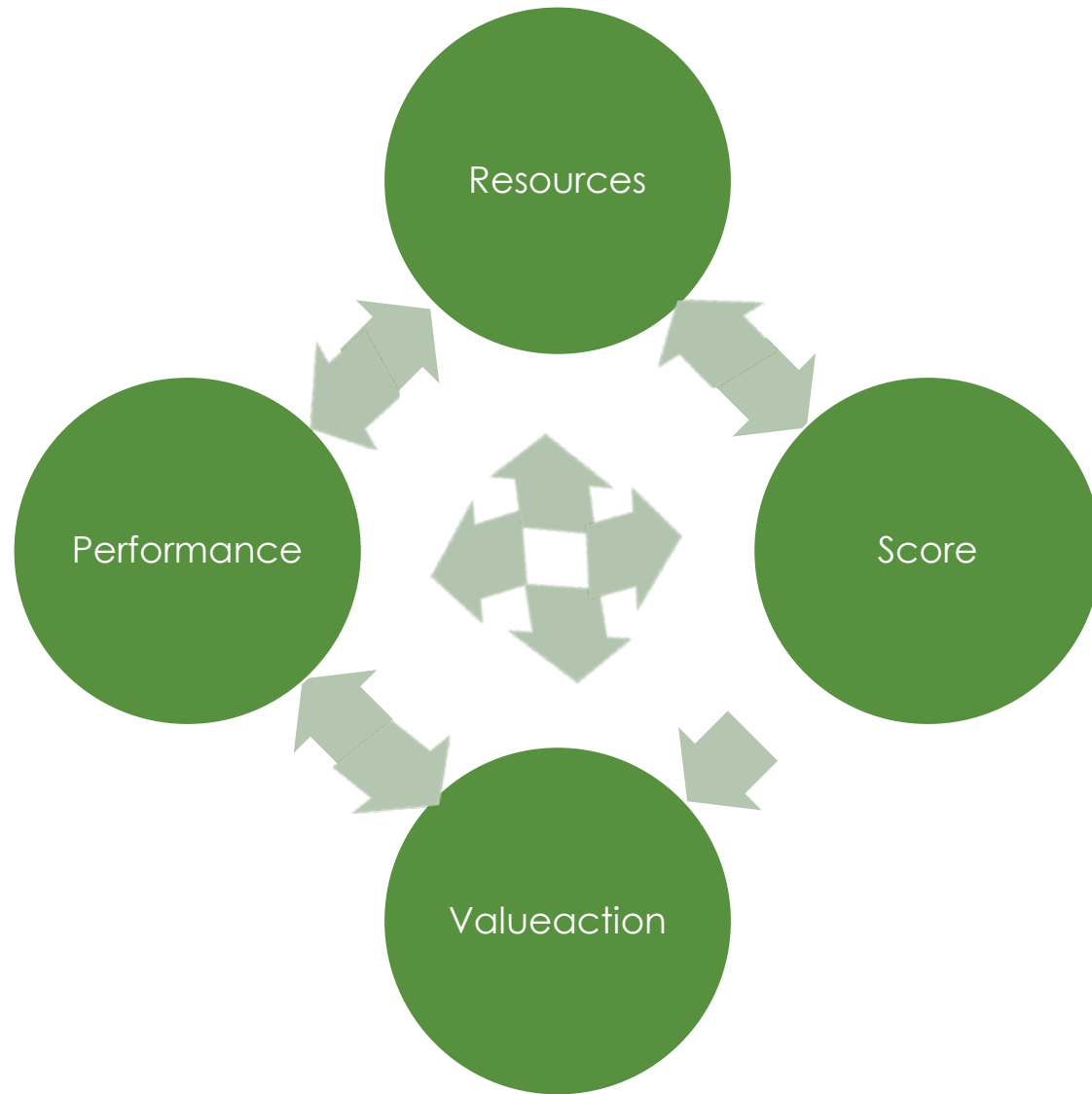
TELL THE STORY OF WHAT'S

RSVP Method

R – Resources – What you have

S – Score – The plan for using the resources

V – Valueaction – What you want participants to feel/do/act upon

P – Performance – How the work is executed

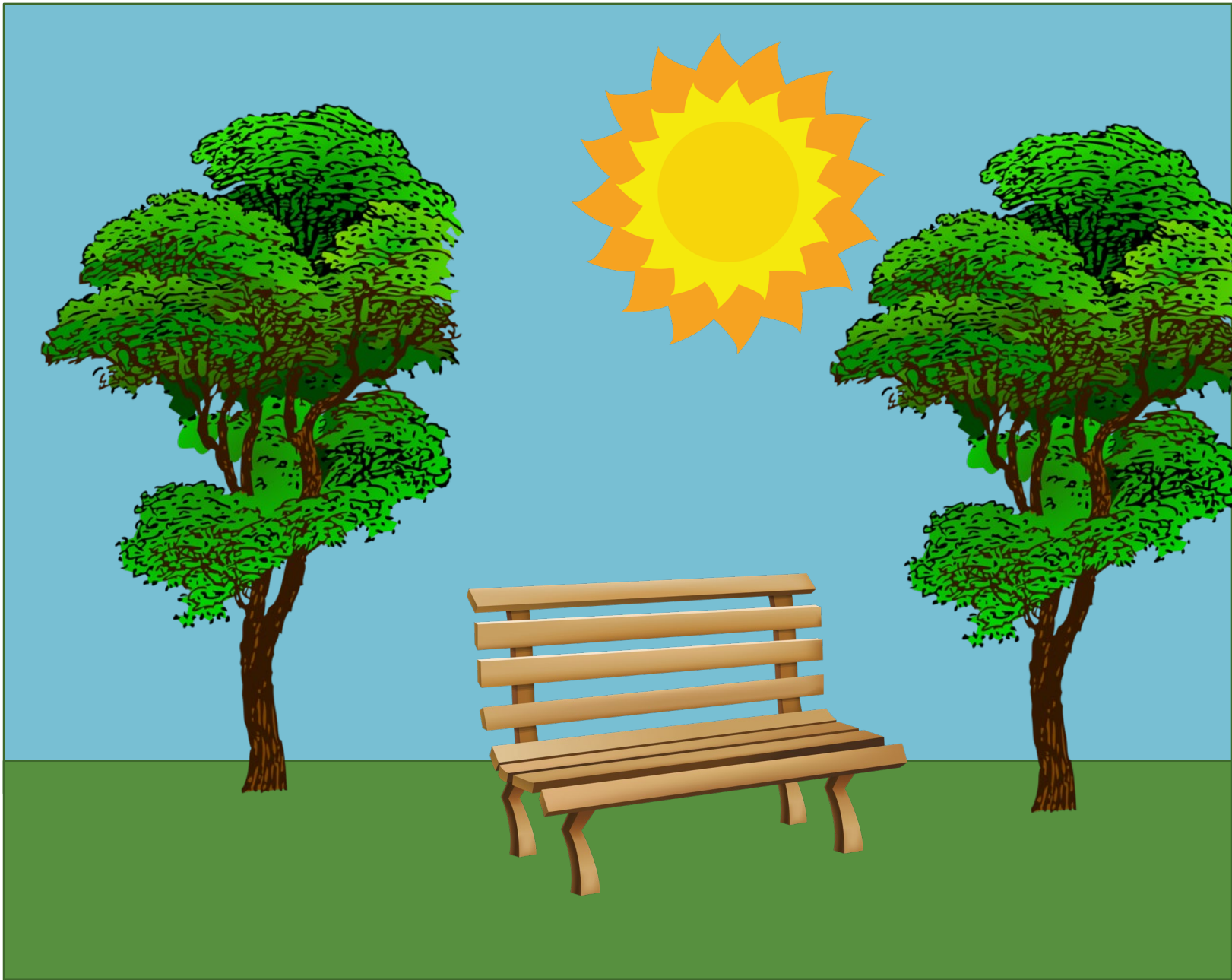
An RSVP Example

Add a resource

Place the resource in such a way that people will interact with the resource (score)

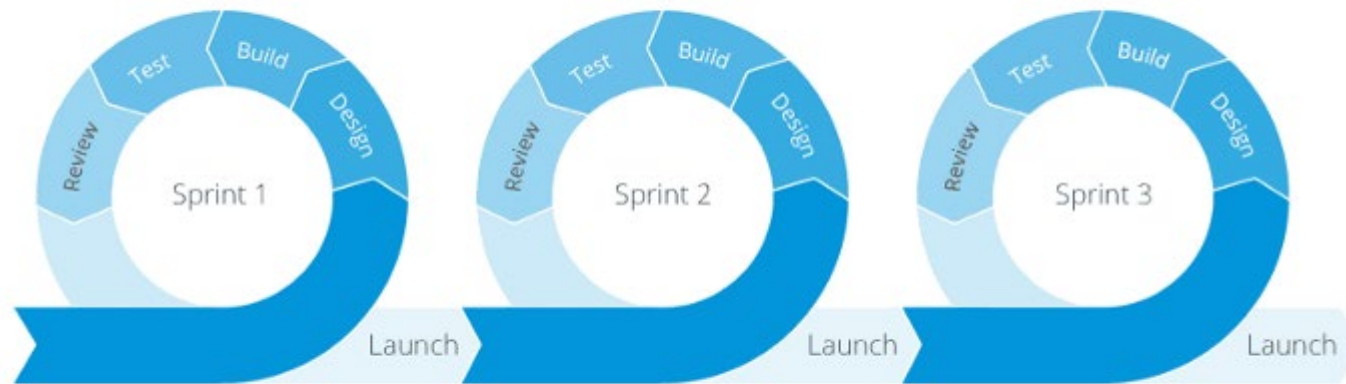
Test the valueaction through performance



An RSVP Example

When the resources change, you have to reconsider the rest of the RSVP cycle.

Sprints

1. What's the problem?
2. Build the solution.
3. Test and review.
4. Launch.
