Overview

Saint Leo University's Master of Social Work program is a CSWE accredited, innovative, full-time online program. The MSW program is only available to residents that reside in Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, Mississippi, Texas, Virginia, Tennessee, North Carolina, New Jersey, Maryland and Illinois. Classes are attended via webcam allowing face to face interaction in the convenience of your own home. Given the format of this program, students should enter the program knowing that they will have to meet for weekly evening classes (Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays (Saturday meets are only for Saturday Cohort)) via webcam, be available for weekday daytime internship hours, attend one weekend seminar on University campus in the summer, and adjust their lives to meet the demands and expectations of this program.

The Master of Social Work Program mission is to prepare graduate students for professional advanced practice in becoming leaders through the provision of social work services that promote social and economic justice, and human rights locally, nationally and globally. The program further expects graduates to contribute to the empowerment of people/groups that experience discrimination and oppression.
