Check in with us! Let your admissions counselor know you received your letter and where you are in your decision process. This is a great time to address any questions or concerns you may have, which enables your counselor to help you get the information you need.

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after October 1. You can apply online by visiting fafsa.ed.gov. Be sure to add Saint Leo to your Top 10 School List by using the Saint Leo University federal school code: 001526.

Submit your deposit as soon as possible to reserve your place in the incoming class. Visit saintleo.edu/deposit for details on all the ways you can deposit. Submitting your enrollment deposit will allow you to begin the next steps in the process, such as submitting your housing application and completing placement testing.

Plan to attend one of our new student events here on campus or schedule a campus visit. Visit saintleo.edu/visit-campus for updated event information.
