University Campus Student Fees

Students attending University Campus have up to four fees associated with their annual cost of attending Saint Leo University. The information below describes the fees and how they are used.

Student Success Fee

The Student Success Fee is designed to facilitate progress toward degree completion for students attending University Campus.

This fee covers

- Faculty and academic advising
- Tutoring and learning support services
- Supporting writing across the curriculum in Read, Write, Transform
- At risk student support including peer to peer counseling
- Enhancing academic programs, availability of courses, and general student resources

Student Activity Fee

The Student Activity Fee is used to fund student organizations, programs, services, and events that engage students, help them learn about themselves and others, and to foster a sense of community among our student body. The fee supports Student Activities events and programming, Student Government, student organizations, and Campus Activities Board.

Examples include:

- Off campus trips: outdoor recreational activities, sporting events, theme park trips, trips to plays
- Campus activities: Bingo nights, live music at Benedict's Coffeehouse patio, Club Leo, leadership training
- Arts & speakers: comedy shows, spoken word events, general performances
- Student clubs and organizations
- Special speakers, panels, workshops, training, exercise classes, and more

Technology Fee

The Technology Fee is essential to ensuring that Saint Leo delivers the best classroom experience for all of our students.

Examples include:

- Audio/visual equipment for in person and online courses
- Physical computers in common areas

- Technical enhancements needed for classroom software programs
- Expanding infrastructure and funding capital improvements

Orientation Fee

The Orientation Fee is a one-time fee for new, incoming students (free for family members). New Student Orientation (NSO) includes a variety of programs and events that will set students on the path toward academic and personal success at Saint Leo University. Students and their families become acquainted with our campus, support services, policies, staff and faculty. The programs are a combination of in person and virtual with virtual programming available throughout the academic year. Multiple events are planned for students to begin their friendships with other new and returning students.

Through programs offered, students and their families will be informed about the opportunities and responsibilities in and outside of the classroom. By exposing students to the key services and opportunities available to them, we hope to empower students to make well-informed decisions. NSO is mandatory for all first-year and transfer students attending University Campus.

Health Fee

The per semester Health Fee provides unlimited primary health care at the Student Health Center. There is no additional cost for most care on site except for laboratory work and some other specialized care or referrals. The current Student Health Center and the Wellness Center offer expanded hours, many free medications and inoculations, 24/7 virtual care, and an increased health staff among other benefits. This fee is separate from the health insurance fee and cannot be waived.
