Quest Speaker: Dr. Joan a. Reid, MHC, CRC Director of the USF Trafficking in Persons Risk to Resilience Research Lab.

Dr. Reid received her MA in Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling and Ph.D. in Criminology from the University of South Florida. Dr. Reid has authored over 60 publications primarily focused on child sex trafficking in Florida. She was recently ranked the 5<sup>th</sup> most active human trafficking researcher in the world. Her work has been cited over 2,000 times by other academics. The real-world impact of her research is extensive, appearing as a citing authority in human trafficking cases in various State Supreme Courts and an amicus brief related to the U.S. Supreme Court case *Jane Doe vs. Backpage*. Dr. Reid's research has been cited in state and federal government agency policy reports on child trafficking in Florida, California, and in National Reports to the U.S. Congress.
