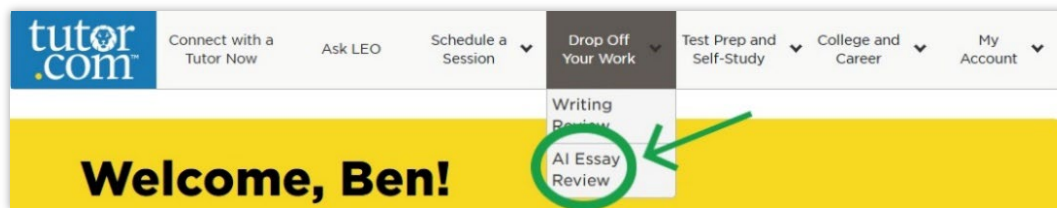


Important Tutor.com Updates!

Another new, exciting feature for Saint Leo students is the **Ask LEO® chatbot**, a Socratic-minded chatbot that asks questions, but never gives answers. Students can find instant, on-demand help in dozens of subjects. The built-in pedagogy and best practices for offering support include Socratic questioning, ongoing encouragement, and scaffolded support. Students have the option to connect with a live tutor at any time.
