

## University Campus Student Fees (2026–2027)

Students attending the University Campus are assessed mandatory fees that support essential services, programs, and experiences that contribute to academic success and campus life. The information below explains each required fee and how it is used. These fees are reviewed regularly to ensure transparency, value, and alignment with student needs.

### Student Services Fee

Beginning in the 2026–2027 academic year, Saint Leo University has consolidated several required fees into a single **Student Services Fee**. This change was made to simplify billing and reduce the overall cost to students, while continuing to provide critical academic, technology, student engagement, and campus support services.

The Student Services Fee supports a wide range of services and resources, including but not limited to:

- Faculty and academic advising
  - Tutoring and learning support services
  - Supporting writing across the curriculum in Read, Write, Transform
  - Support for at-risk students, including peer-to-peer counseling
  - Enhancements to academic programs, course availability, and general student resources
  - Classroom and instructional technology, including audio/visual equipment and software
  - Technology infrastructure, system upgrades, and computers in common areas
  - Student organizations, programs, services, and campus-wide events
  - Access to the Saint Leo University Wellness Center, including recreation and fitness facilities, group exercise classes, Counseling Services, and University Ministry. The Wellness Center features modern fitness areas, an indoor walking track, multipurpose courts, and an infinity edge recreational pool.

### Student Activity Fee

The **Student Activity Fee** is dedicated **100% to student activities and engagement**. This fee directly funds programs, organizations, and events that enhance campus life and foster a sense of community among our student body.

The fee supports Student Activities events and programming, Student Government, student organizations, and the Campus Activities Board. Examples include:

- Off-campus trips such as outdoor recreation, sporting events, theme park visits, and cultural outings
  - On-campus activities including bingo nights, live music at Benedict's Coffeehouse patio, Club Leo, and leadership training
  - Arts and speakers such as comedy shows, performances, panels, and workshops
  - Student clubs and organizations
  - Special programs, training, exercise classes, and other engagement opportunities

## **Orientation Fee**

The **Orientation Fee** is a one-time fee for new, incoming students (free for family members). New Student Orientation (NSO) is mandatory for all first-year and transfer students attending University Campus.

NSO includes a variety of in-person and virtual programs designed to support a successful transition to Saint Leo University. Students and their families become familiar with campus resources, support services, policies, faculty, and staff, while beginning to build connections within the campus community. Virtual programming remains available throughout the academic year.
